Background

Maurice Noonan Agricultural Contractors is a family run business which offers a range of agricultural services to local farmers and businesses in the East Cork area of Southern Ireland. During the various farming seasons they provide services such as ploughing, fertiliser and silage spreading, setting & harvesting of crops and cutting & baling of silage.

As the business had no accounting software, customer invoices were hand written and recording of sales and purchases for VAT purposes were all recorded in Sales and Purchasing Ledger Books.

Brief

Maurice Noonan required an easy to use accounting system that could be maintained by family members to quickly produce customer invoices, manage customer and supplier accounts and general ledger transactions. Maurice Noonan enlisted the services of Diomac Business Systems (aka Neotech) to supply a simple but effective accounting package and also to assist in the initial setting up of the accounts.

Execution

The Dynacom deluxe package was selected as the most suitable option for the Noonan business. Due to time restrictions, Maurice Noonan requested that the Diomac accounts department assist them in the set up of the purchases, sales and general ledger. This included the set up of customers, suppliers, services and general ledger codes. Customer Invoice templates were also created using the Dynacom report generator.

Result

Maurice Noonan was surprised to learn that he offered over 60 different services to more than 200 customers and used in excess of 100 different suppliers. By replacing his traditional bookkeeping methods with the easy to use Dynacom Deluxe he has greatly reduced his administrative work load and finds it much easier to keep track of both customer and supplier accounts.
